MNCC BAR PROCEDURES DURING COVID-19 – updated 29 Sep 2020

Following a recent update to the Covid-19 Risk Assessment, the following procedures will be put in place from the weekend 3 - 4 October 2020. Please be aware that current circumstances dictate that short notice changes may be required. Any changes to these procedures will be communicated to our duty volunteers ('staff') as soon as possible.

Any member who is uncomfortable with these procedures, or their ability to comply with them will not be expected to fulfil their bar duty, although advance notice of this would be appreciated.

BAR & Till

1. The bar will be cleaned every Tuesday, Saturday and Sunday.
2. Cash will be placed in envelopes and bar cashing-up will be completed on Tuesdays.
3. Stock will be filled up on Tuesdays.
4. Nobody will be allowed in the bar area apart from the 'staff'.
5. Masks and gloves will be provided for 'staff'.
6. Assistance with the till will only be given by a member of the bar committee, who will wear PPE and not actually touch the till.

'CUSTOMER' AREAS

7. Tables will be placed at least 2 metres apart and are not to be moved, other than by the bar committee.
8. No more than 6 people may be at one table.
9. There is to be no other mixing at tables and if someone leaves a table that place may not be taken by another.
10. Contact tracing requires a record of name, phone number, time and table used. This will be maintained by the 'staff'.
11. Drinks will only be available by Table service.
12. Glasses will be collected by the 'staff' and will be run through 2 cleaning cycles.
13. Ice will only be placed in drinks by the 'staff'.
14. The bin will be emptied and cleaned on completion of weekend service.

Members using the bar ('customers') will be expected to comply with these procedures; failure to do so will result in them being asked to leave the bar and may result in the bar being closed. Patience and politeness will go a long way to making both the running and the enjoyment of the bar something we would all wish to partake in.
